His voice will continue to be heard as friends enjoy and play his two CDs, "Criminal Mischief and "Shades and Blinds." Thomas was especially honored when asked to open for "HOT TUNA" at the Criterion Theatre in 2001. Thomas' love for reading often brought him to the local library.
